This Administrative Order is issued in accordance with Michigan Court Rules 8.110(C) and 8.111(B) and from the Michigan Supreme Court/State Court Administrative Office blanket assignment. It covers the entry of an Order of Case Assignment for Drug/Sobriety Court ordering a defendant to participate in the 61<sup>st</sup> District Court Drug/Sobriety Court. Specifically, the order includes:

The defendant is ordered to participate in the 61<sup>st</sup> District Court Drug/Sobriety Court under the jurisdiction of the Honorable Patrick C. Bowler. The defendant agrees to sign the participation agreement and abide by all terms and conditions of the agreement as a condition of sentence.

The case is assigned to the Honorable Patrick C. Bowler through the blanket assignment to assist with non-disqualification matters issued by the Michigan Supreme Court/State Court Administrative Office and as directed by the Chief Judge of the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court.

The Honorable Patrick C. Bowler will maintain jurisdiction of the case for all matters, including guilty plea, sentencing, and monitoring of the Drug/Sobriety Court Probation Agreement. If a probation revocation is ordered by Judge Bowler, the originally assigned Circuit Judge will reassume jurisdiction of the case unless otherwise ordered by the Chief Circuit Judge.
